

## Lenten Scripture Helpers

1. Then answered Peter, and said unto Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here: if thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles; one for thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias.

2. And if a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand.  
Source: *Mark (ch. III, v. 25)*
3. But you be strong and do not lose courage, for there is reward for your work. [Chronicles 15:7].
4. For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again. [Proverbs 24:16].
5. I said, Days should speak, and multitude of years should teach wisdom.

6. For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. [1 Timothy 6:7].
7. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
