Please be aware of your presence on the Altar and in the Pew during Mass. Refrain from fidgeting and unnecessary talking. Please remember that a really good altar server does not draw attention away from the Mass.

Fr. Ronnie has mentioned that during the recession you should watch the priest and either bow or genuflect depending on what they do. Fr. Ronnie tends to genuflect, and Fr. Bilinsky tends to bow, but watch and take your cue from them.

Please be on the lookout for new information regarding the liturgical changes that will be in effect soon. I have a meeting with Fr. Ronnie this week to discuss if this will change any procedures for altar servers.
