The attached documents are to be brought to the Meeting with the Music Director. A cantor will be available to sing through selections. The music director will be present to answer any questions and to play through all of the music. Do not hire musicians on your own! See attached guidelines.

Wedding Music Guidelines

Marriage is a sacrament, a visible sign of God's grace. This is the day you affirm your love and commitment not only to each other, but also to the parish community. It is not a private ceremony, but a liturgy (a work of the people) in the truest sense of the word - one that involves your families and friends. May it ring with joyful song!

Because of the solemnity of this sacrament, only sacred, liturgical music is acceptable for your wedding ceremony or mass. Show tunes, pop music, secular love songs, operatic wedding songs, etc., are **not** considered appropriate for your wedding ceremony. Save them for the reception!

Cantors at weddings encourage participation in your wedding ceremony; they also sing the psalm and Gospel acclamations, whether you are having just a ceremony, or a full mass. In addition, our cantors are familiar with the music in our hymnals. We will provide you with a list of Mary, Queen of Peace Church approved musicians. Our cantor/vocalist fees are listed on the attached fee sheet. Brass and string player's fees are also noted. The organist fee is \$200 per wedding. Since wedding rehearsals are mainly blocking for the wedding participants (who stands where, etc.), the organist and cantor do not attend.

We require that you use only those organists and cantor/vocalists on our music staff. In addition, all instrumentalists will be taken from MQP's approved list. This is to ensure the integrity of the Liturgical celebration. Your wedding music coordinator will be Lindsey Piattoly. Please note that the organists receive an additional \$50 rehearsal fee for any extra rehearsals required with outside singers or outside musicians of any kind. Our musicians are familiar with the wedding music repertoire on these sheets, and a rehearsal for that music is not necessary.

Please remember: *our cantors must be used for the liturgy*. Outside singers may only sing prelude music or non-congregational songs, keeping in mind the directives of the 2nd paragraph above. If you plan to retain the services of an outside vocalist besides a cantor, they should provide an original copy (no Xeroxes please!) of the music they will sing in the key suited to their voice to the accompanying organist. There are stiff penalties for violating copyright laws -- we ask that you please observe them.

Fees are due to all musicians (cantors, instrumentalists, and/or organist) one month prior to the wedding. Checks should be made payable to each individual musician and *sent in one envelope to Lindsey Piattoly*, Director of Music Ministry, 1501 W. Causeway Approach Mandeville, LA 70471.

Everyone on Mary, Queen of Peace's music staff is committed to helping to make your marriage ceremony a spiritual and meaningful celebration through music and prayer.

RESPONSORIAL PSALM – The psalm between the two readings is sung by the cantor and the congregation. All of the choices are appropriate for other instruments to join in. Please choose one of the following:

- ρ Psalm 24 . REFRAIN: “I Have Loved You” (Joncas)
I have loved you with an everlasting love, I have called you and your are Mine. (repeat)
- ρ Psalm 33 . REFRAIN: “The Earth is Full of Beauty” (Cotter)
The earth is full of beauty, the goodness of a loving God. (repeat)
- ρ Psalm 34 . REFRAIN: “Taste and See, the Goodness of the Lord.” (Haugen)
Taste and see the goodness of the Lord, the goodness of the Lord.
- ρ Psalm 103 . REFRAIN: “The Lord is Kind and Merciful.” (Cotter)
*The Lord is kind and merciful; the Lord is kind and merciful.
Slow to anger, rich in kindness, the Lord is kind and merciful.*
- ρ Psalm 118 . REFRAIN: “This is the Day the Lord Has Made; Let Us Rejoice and Be Glad.” (Joncas)
This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad. (repeat)
- ρ Psalm 128 . REFRAIN: “Blest are Those Who Love You.” (Haugen)
Blest are those who love you, happy those who follow you, blest are those who seek you, O God.
